

10 Years On the Line: My War On the Border

A recently published book from a 1969 graduate of Northside High School in Warner Robins is spreading like wildfire nationwide. "10 Years On the Line: My War On the Border" is a factual account of this retired immigration/CBP officer's efforts to enforce immigration laws at the nation's most corrupt Port of Entry - Douglas, Arizona.

Extracted from hundreds of carefully preserved incident reports, memorandums and investigation records the author details the daily struggle he had with management and others to prevent illegal aliens and criminals of all stripes from entering the United States. Working and living in the most law-enforcement saturated sector of the United States border the author describes in detail experiences both on and off-duty in which he doggedly maintained his idealism and sense of justice against an institutionalized culture of corruption, malfeasance and disloyalty.

Mike Ligon is a native of Oklahoma and a former Marine. After returning from Vietnam he obtained a Criminal Justice degree from Brigham Young University, attended graduate school at Cal. State L.A. and obtained his Master's degree in Public Administration from Webster University while stationed at Ft. Bragg, N.C. He served as an enlisted weapons and communications specialist on an operational detachment with 5th Special Forces Group (ABN) and as a detachment commander in 7th Special Forces Group(ABN). Upon branch transferring to military intelligence he served in a variety of assignments as a 35E counterintelligence officer in multiple Special Forces assignments. Mike retired from the U.S. army in 1996 and Customs & Border Protection in 2006. He is considered a subject matter expert on counterinsurgency and taught extensively at the U.S. Army Intelligence Center and School, Ft. Huachuca, AZ.
